GROUP CLASSES

69. Produce-of-Dam: Two animals shown in single entry classes, either sex, from one dam, may be owned by more than one exhibitor.
70. Get-of-Sire: Four animals shown in single entry classes, both sexes represented, may be owned by more than one exhibitor.
71. Best-Six-Head: All animals must have been shown in their respective single entry classes and they must be owned by the exhibitor or by an immediate family member.

2019-2020 SPECIAL RULES FOR UNITED BRAFORD BREEDERS POINTS SHOWS

ASSOCIATION POINTS SHOW RULES

1. Animals must be registered by the United Braford Breeders to compete in this association-sponsored show. Owners must be members of United Braford Breeders in good standing. Cattle must be classified as 3/8 Brahman 5/8 Hereford Braford to be eligible to show in the Braford Show. All other registered Braford cattle (any combination of Brahman/Hereford genetics other than 3/8 Brahman 5/8 Hereford) are eligible for the Braford Base Show.
2. The UBB has five sanctioned open Braford and Braford Base point shows that constitute the Braford Show Bull and Heifer of the Year and the Braford Base Show Heifer of the Year recognition program. These five shows are:

The Four States Fair, The State Fair of Louisiana, Fort Worth Stock Show, Dixie Nationals, the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. (Noting that the Braford Base show is not available at the Fort Worth Stock Show)

3. An animal found to have evidence of incisions, surgical or otherwise, in the following areas: testicles, sheath, navel, or dewlap will be disqualified from showing.
4. Animals unethically fitted to alter the conformation or appearance of the animal will be disqualified. Cattle displaying tail ties and hairnets used on the tail will be allowed.
5. Calves shown at the side of Braford and Braford Base cows must be registered purebred Brafords.
6. Bred Braford Base female shown must have available the registration number of the service sire to verify and validate that the pregnancy will produce a purebred Braford.
7. All Braford entries are subject to the provision of a rule of the United Braford Breeders entitled "Inspection of Exhibits."
 - a. The association and its representatives have the authority to require such tests as they deem necessary to verify the accuracy of the classification and pedigree of exhibited animals. "Said authority shall extend to and cover the enforcement of all Show rules as adopted by the UBB."
 - b. Each exhibitor shall submit his registered Braford cattle to such tests and examinations as requested and/or required by the association, its authorized representatives, or the authorized representatives of the relevant show. These tests and examinations shall include but are not limited to any weighing, measuring, or ultrasound evaluation of the animals as required by the UBB's Show Committee.
 - c. For and in consideration of the opportunity to participate in any Braford function, exhibitor hereby releases the Association, its officers, directors, and representatives from negligence, any and all claims, suits and judgments past, present or future, arising from or connected with the administration or use of such test or examination and the resulting decisions therefrom.
8. All protests must be made in writing and be accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00 which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Such protests must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal and must be delivered to the UBB Show Committee immediately after occasion for each protest. Depending on the basis of the protest, a decision may be withheld until complete investigation is completed.
