The National Junior Braford Association Directors are selected to serve a two-year term representing the Braford breed. Directors serve as the arms of the NJBA and work with the Youth Committee to assist with a variety of leadership responsibilities such as, serving as show ring stewards, fundraising projects, and assisting with NJBA events and programs at the state summer shows and the All American. Directors are expected to be dressed neatly and represent the NJBA in a professional manner at all times.

Application Qualifications

1. Applicants must be at least 11 years old on June 1 of the year in which they are elected.
2. Applicant must be a member of the National Junior Braford Association.
3. Applications may be submitted via email to ubb@brafords.org by **July 20** or brought printed out to the All American.
4. Elections will take place at the membership meeting held during the NJBA All American. Please be prepared to verbally tell the membership why you are worthy of their consideration for a board position during the membership meeting. Six members with the highest vote totals will be elected.
5. Candidates are allowed to bring a campaign poster (no larger than a standard piece of poster board) to be posted at the meeting site. This poster should include a current photo, a list of previous Braford offices and honors received and a list of other significant school and community activities.
